BG Kemper commissioned as an Infantry Officer into the U.S. Army in 1995 after graduation from the University of Illinois and served at Fort Riley, KS and Fort Lewis, WA. The remainder of his distinguished career has been in numerous command and staff assignments in the Minnesota Army National Guard. BG Kemper is currently the Deputy Commanding General for Support to the 34th Infantry Division Forward, supporting Operation SPARTAN SHIELD in Kuwait. His career includes four deployments to Kosovo (Operation JOINT GUARDIAN) and Kuwait (Operation NEW DAWN). His latest command was the 1st Armored Brigade Combat Team of the 34th Infantry Division. In the civilian sector, he has served in several engineering roles since he left active duty. These positions include Program Manager and a Director of Design Assurance for Boston Scientific and a Director of Post Market Quality Assurance for Global Complaint Investigation Sites. BG Kemper has also earned a second master's degree in 2016 from the U.S Army War College.
