BG (Ret.) Robert Upp started his army career as an infantry officer and transferred to the 36th Division in the Texas National Guard. In 1941, he was called to active duty and served as a Company Commander. He fought in the Aleutian Islands from 1943 to 1944, then was transferred to the 65th Division in the European Theater of Operations until the end of the war. In 1951, he served in the Korean War as a war Crimes Investigator and Historian. After Korea, he continued to practice law and served as a law professor at the Los Angeles City College. He remained in the USAR and served as a Deputy Commandant of the JAG School and was a special assistant to the Army's Judge Advocate General. He retired in 1976. BG Upp passed away on the 13th of March, 2015 in San Diego, CA.
