Colonel Barr was assigned as the intelligence officer for the 3rd Armored Division in July, 1942. He led numerous teams to provide information on the enemy for Combat Commanders, other divisions, and higher headquarters. His Legion of Merit citation commended Barr for "his masterful analysis of enemy information". Barr became the division's Chief of Staff in September, 1945 and retired on June, 1946. After his military service, he resumed his position as a research accountant at the SEC and became the chief accountant in 1956. He received many awards including the Federal Civilian Distinguished Service Award by President Dwight Eisenhower on March, 1960.
