Mr. Charles Finn commissioned into the U.S. Army Reserve in 1955 after graduating from the University of Illinois in July 1956. In 1982, Mr. Finn accepted the Vice President position at Flexsteel Industries before becoming a partner of the Professional Furniture Marketing Corporation until he retired in 2009. Mr. Finn was a strong supporter of the University of Illinois, being members of the President's Council of the U of I Foundation, the Business Activity Council, and the Chairman of the College of Business.
