Mr. Thomas Martin accepted a commission as a Military Intelligence Officer with a secondary branch of Infantry. In 1971, he started his 35 year career in the U.S. State Department as a Foreign Service Officer. Overseas postings spanned East Asia (Taiwan, China, and Singapore) and the Western Hemisphere (Jamaica, Argentina). Assignments in Washington, D.C. included heading U.S. negotiating teams in multilateral economic negotiations in London & Paris, and bilateral civil aviation negotiations throughout Asian. Senior positions included: Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for International Narcotics and Law Enforcement; Deputy Chief of Mission (Deputy Ambassador) in Buenos Aires, Argentina; and Senior OIG Inspector for American Embassies in Afghanistan & North Africa. After his diplomatic career, he joined the firm of Booz Allex Hamilton as an Associate and worked at the Department of Homeland Affairs' national headquarters counter-terrorism program and the Defense Intelligence Agency.
