Mr. William Takakoshi served in the U.S. Army Reserves from 1970 until separating in 1978. Mr. Takakoshi began his 28 years of government service in 1970 as an Industrial Engineer with the Department of Navy at Crane, Indiana. From 1975 through 1978 he was responsible for planning, acquisition and management of all the resources required to activate the missile facilities of the Navy's first TRIDENT submarine base in Silverdale, WA. From 1978 through 1981 he was the deputy of the Production Branch of the joint Navy/Air Force cruise missile office. He served in the office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Research, Development and Acquisition from 1981 to 1990. In 1990, he was appointed as the Senior Executive Service Special Assistant to the Under Secretary of the Army. He was extensively involved in Army coordination with Congress, other military dependents and the Office of the Secretary of Defense. Since his retirement in 1998, he has worked as a consultant for Hurt Norton and Associates.
